#### **PROGRAM OVERVIEW**

The Master's in Educational Leadership and Policy Studies (ELPS) is designed for persons preparing to become administrators or specialists in education-related professions. The ELPS Department requires that Masters students pass the School Leaders Licensure Assessment (SLLA) administered by ETS before completing the academic program. A passing score on the exam is necessary for K-12 Administrative Level 1 Certification.

The 36-credit hour program also includes a practicum that is a fulltime mentored experience under the supervision of a field supervisor in an assigned school, school district or approved educational organization.
